








Home Learning for Pupils on Purple Mash

When logging in, pupils can use either the keyboard or follow colour coded login pad.

Children can access a range of learning tools and activities via the Purple Mash website. Once logged on, children can find activities and games to practise basic skills.

All pupils have their own login details. These have been distributed to children.

 <p>Tools</p>	<p>When pupils go onto the Tools app, they will find a range of ways to present their learning in different subject areas. The children can select ways to design, write or plan out what they have learnt using a variety of different templates from Purple Mash.</p> <p>Check the videos alongside these for guidance.</p>
 <p>Games</p>	<p>When pupils go onto the Games app, they will find a range of ways to practice their learning in different subject areas. These activities are fun, interactive and reinforce basic skills.</p>
 <p>Serial Mash</p>	<p>When pupils go onto the Serial Mash app, they will find a wide variety of books and reading materials aimed at children from Y2. Children can select books to read or alternatively teachers may set a book for your child to read and practice key words and reading skills.</p>
 <p>Mini Mash</p>	<p>The MINI Mash app is aimed at in EYFS and KS1.</p> <p>It is interactive and has lots of guidance to help children practice their learning at home ranging from reading key words, counting, identifying letter sounds and much more.</p>
 <p>2Dos</p>	<p>2Dos is where you find activities and tasks set by the teacher. This allows children to complete tasks online and send learning back to the teacher. Check this regularly.</p>
