### Homework:

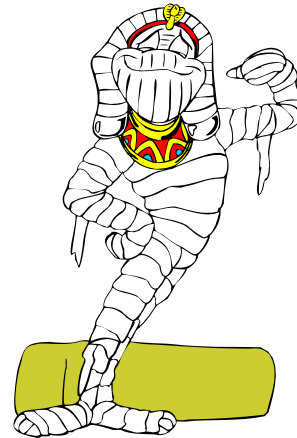
Maths and Literacy homework will be given out on a Tuesday to be returned to school on a Friday. If there are any issues with your child's homework, please feel free to come and see me.
