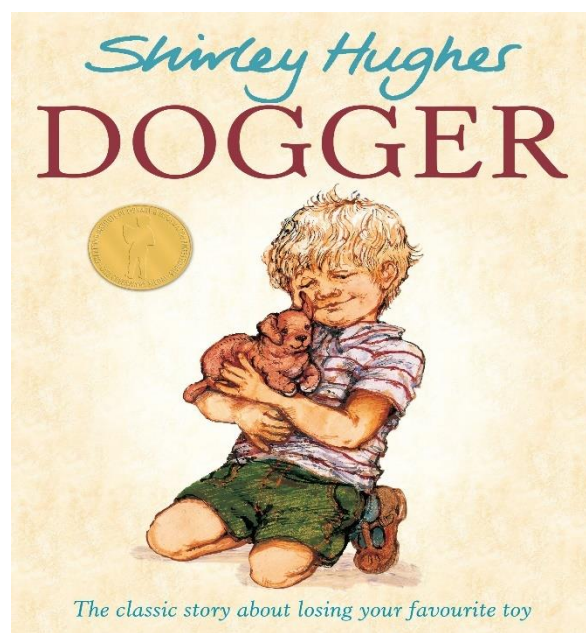


# CHILDREN'S BOOK REVIEWS.

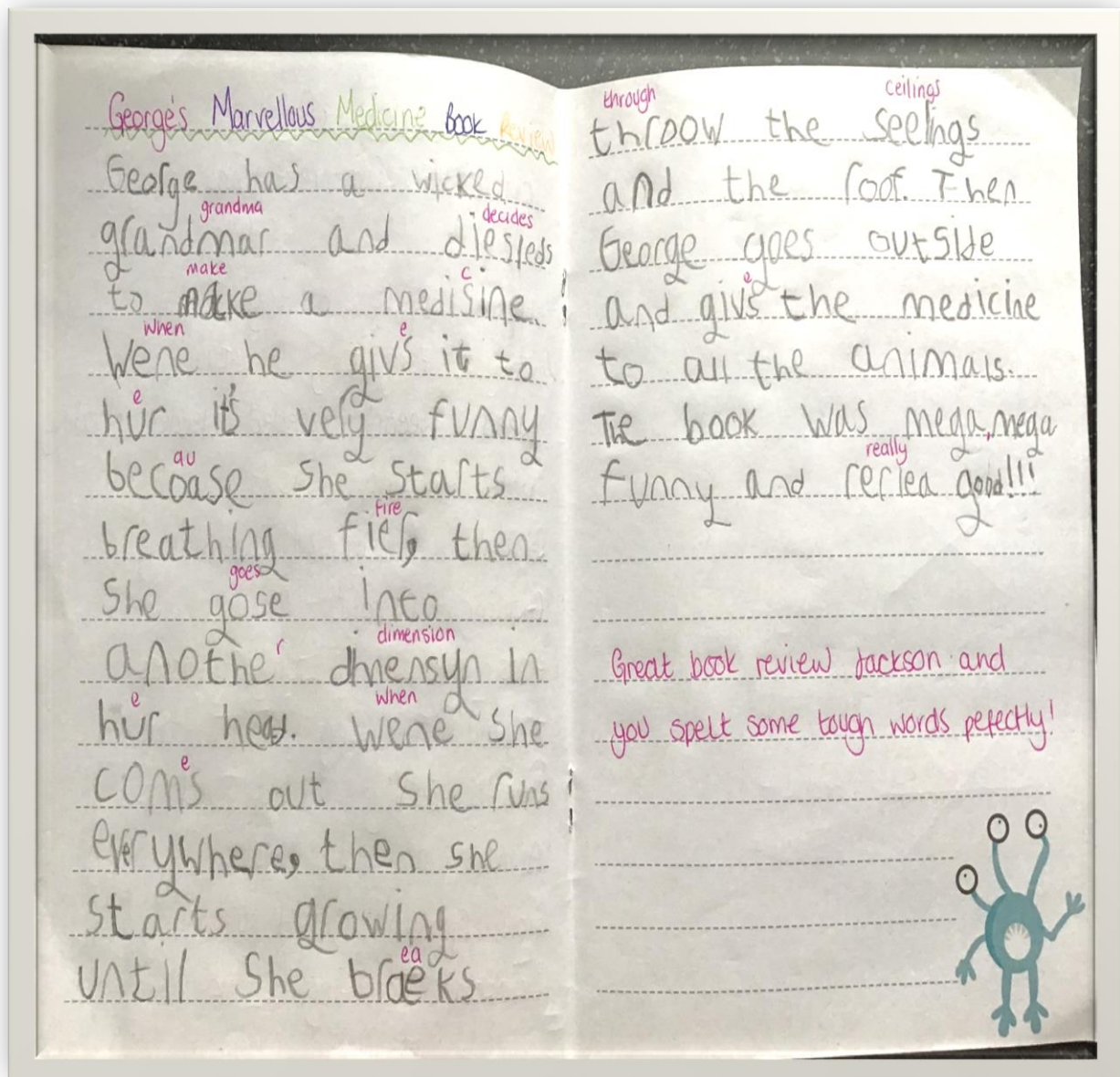

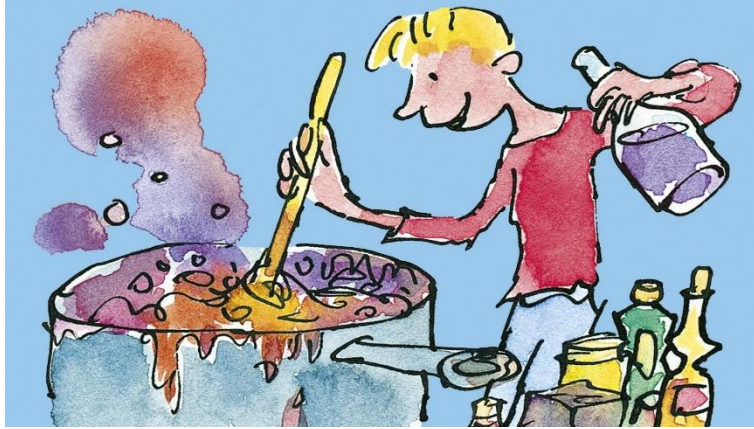

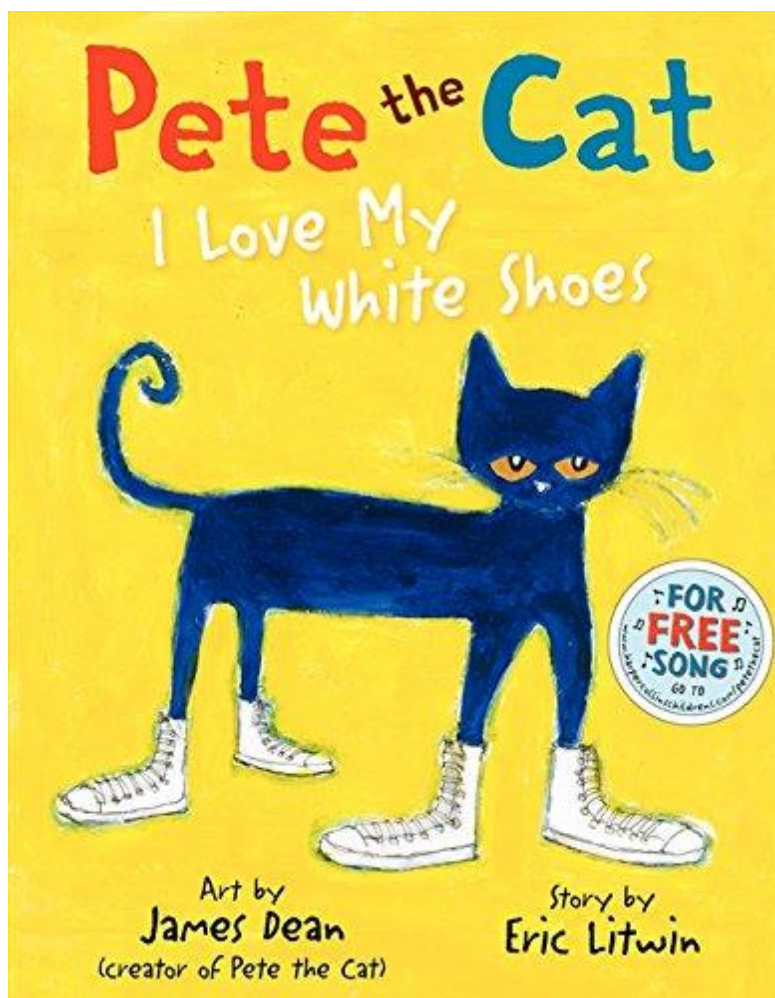

## The Nursery.

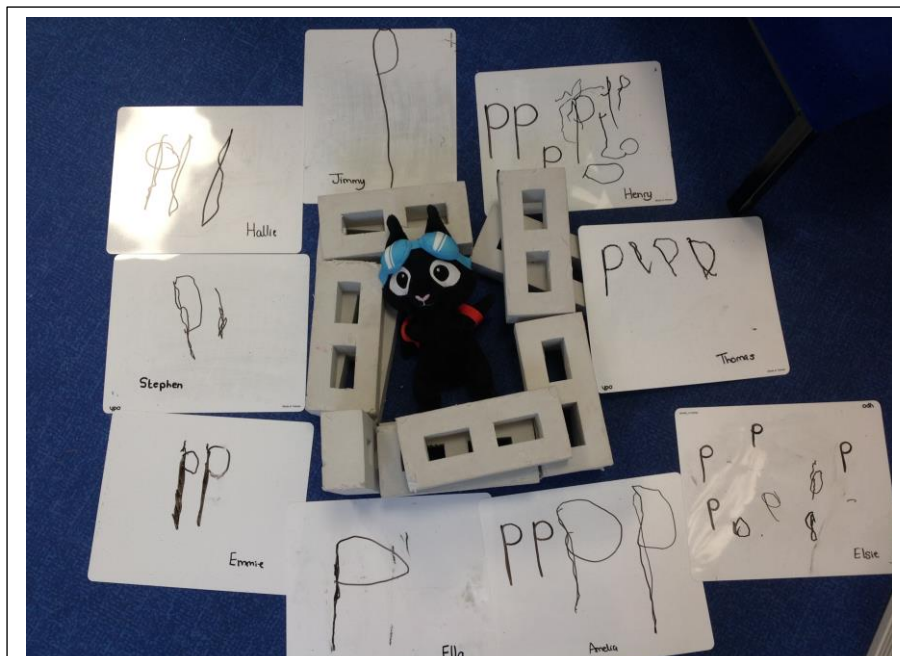

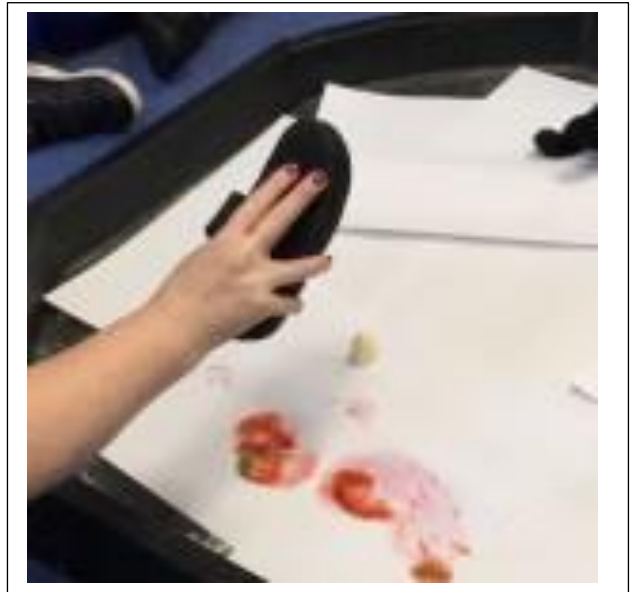


Retelling the story and matching scenes.
