

As readers, we will read a variety of books based on toys over time. Children will develop in their comprehension, inference and prediction skills.



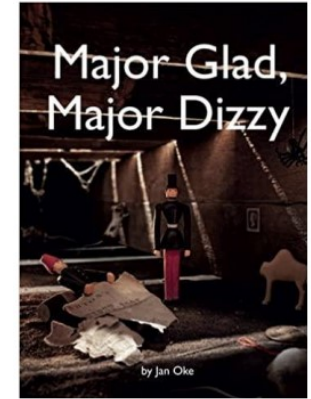
As learners of religion, our themes for study are:
