In English, we will be learning to:

- Write an exploration narrative.
- Write a formal report.
- Understand the difference between vocabulary of informal speech and vocabulary appropriate to formal speech and writing – formal tone and the structures in writing.
- Indicate degrees of possibility using modal verbs.
- Linking ideas across paragraphs, using adverbials.

As geographers, we will learn about:

- Identifying lines of latitude, including those already known such as the equator on maps.
- Identifying and understand what lines of longitude are and identify them on maps or globes.
- Begin to use four figure references and locate places on maps, globes or in atlases.
- Understanding how lines of latitude and longitude are used to identify time zones.

As musicians, we will learn about:

- A melody (or a tune) being a group of notes played one after another.
- Harmony meaning notes which are played at the same time, like chords.
- How music brings us together.

As artists, we will develop skills in:

- Exploring and appreciating the work of Peter Thorpe and the aspects of abstract art.
- Practising sketching features of abstract art using Thorpe's work for inspiration.
- Creating and experimenting with mixing and using paints in different ways.
