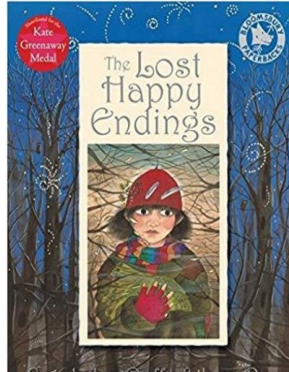


In English we will:
